

### OHIO IS GOOD FOR BUSINESS

The cost of living in Ohio's significant cities is 42-70% lower than San Francisco and New York City. Ohio Ranks No. 3 in Moody's Housing Affordability Index, which measures the combination of higher median income and lower housing price, providing a good quality of life (2020, Q3).
